7	Sec. 101.673. USE OF TEXAS APPELATION OF ORIGIN: AMERICAN
8	VITICULTURAL AREA OR COUNTY. (a) In this section, "American
9	viticultural area" has the meaning assigned by 27 C.F.R. Section
10	<u>4.25.</u>
11	(b) A wine that is otherwise entitled to an appelation of
12	origin indicating the wine's origin is an American viticultural
13	area located in this state under federal law or a county within the
14	boundaries of this state may use that appellation only if the wine
15	<u>is:</u>
16	(1) 100 percent by volume fermented juice of grapes or
17	other fruit grown in this state, subject to the requirements of
18	federal law, not less than 90 percent of which is derived from
19	grapes grown within the boundaries of the labeled American
20	viticultural area or county; and

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
