4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 662.114 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 662.114. UTERINE FIBROIDS AWARENESS MONTH. (a) July
8	is Uterine Fibroids Awareness Month to increase awareness of
9	uterine fibroids and to:
10	(1) encourage education and research on uterine
11	fibroids;
12	(2) improve methods for identifying signs and symptoms
13	<u>of uterine fibroids;</u>
14	(3) improve methods for preventing, diagnosing, and
15	treating uterine fibroids; and
16	(4) encourage the establishment of a public education
17	campaign that includes health seminars, medical information
18	panels, community programs, and funding opportunities.
19	(b) Uterine Fibroids Awareness Month shall be regularly
20	observed through appropriate programs and activities to increase
21	awareness of uterine fibroids.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
