13	women receive the information and health care necessary to prevent
14	and treat the condition. The database must include the:
15	(1) demographic attributes of women diagnosed with
16	uterine fibroids; and
17	(2) treatments for uterine fibroids used by health
18	care providers.
19	(b) Information regarding a woman who is diagnosed with or
20	treated for uterine fibroids that is collected by the department
21	and maintained in the database under Subsection (a):
22	(1) may not include any personally identifying
23	information of the woman; and
24	(2) is confidential and may be used only by the

- 3 Sec. 100A.002. UTERINE FIBROID EDUCATION. The department,
- 4 in consultation with the Texas Medical Association, shall identify
- 5 and post on the department's Internet website existing resources
- 6 and educational materials on uterine fibroids to increase public
- 7 awareness of uterine fibroids, including information on and
- 8 awareness of the:
- 9 <u>(1) women of a race or ethnicity that has a</u>
- 10 statistically elevated risk of developing uterine fibroids; and
- 11 (2) range of available treatment options for uterine
- 12 fibroids that include non-hysterectomy treatments and procedures.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
