A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to the purchase and installation of climate control
- 3 systems at facilities operated by the Texas Department of Criminal
- 4 Justice.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. (a) In this section, "department" means the
- 7 Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
- 8 (b) The department shall:
- 9 (1) contract with a private entity through a
- 10 competitive bidding process to purchase and install climate control
- 11 systems at each facility operated by the department that is not
- 12 currently equipped with a climate control system capable of
- 13 maintaining the temperature in the facility at not less than 65
- 14 degrees Fahrenheit or more than 85 degrees Fahrenheit; and
- 15 (2) install the climate control systems in the
- 16 following phases, with each phase consisting of the installation of
- 17 climate control systems at approximately one-third of the
- 18 department's facilities at a cost not to exceed \$100 million per
- 19 phase:
- 20 (A) phase one to be completed not later than
- 21 December 31, 2024;
- (B) phase two to be completed not later than
- 23 December 31, 2026; and
- (C) phase three to be completed not later than

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- 1 December 31, 2028.
- 2 (c) In conducting the competitive bidding process, the
- 3 department shall solicit bids for the entire scope of the project,
- 4 provided that the department may solicit bids for each phase of the
- 5 project if necessary or beneficial.
- 6 (d) In soliciting bids and determining the requirements for
- 7 the phased implementation of the project, the department shall:
- 8 (1) prioritize the efficient use of state resources;
- 9 and
- 10 (2) consider factors such as:
- 11 (A) the type of climate control systems needed
- 12 for each facility, including the architectural design of each
- 13 facility;
- 14 (B) the ability of any existing climate control
- 15 systems in each facility to maintain the air temperature in the
- 16 facility at not less than 65 degrees Fahrenheit or more than 85
- 17 degrees Fahrenheit;
- 18 (C) the comparable abilities of different
- 19 climate control systems to maintain the temperature described by
- 20 Paragraph (B) of this subdivision, including the total cellblock or
- 21 dormitory square footage each system is capable of maintaining at
- 22 that temperature; and
- 23 (D) the use of inmate labor to decrease costs.
- SECTION 2. This Act expires January 1, 2031.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
