A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the investigation of municipal fire fighters. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 614, Government Code, is 4 5 amended by adding Section 614.024 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 614.024. INVESTIGATION OF MUNICIPAL FIRE FIGHTERS REQUIRED. (a) In this section: 7 (1) "Fire fighter" means a paid employee of a 8 9 municipal fire department. (2) "Investigation" means an administrative 10 investigation conducted by a municipality of alleged misconduct by 11 a fire fighter that could result in punitive action against the fire 12 13 fighter. 14 (3) "Punitive action" means a disciplinary suspension, indefinite suspension, demotion in rank, reprimand, or 15 16 any combination of those actions. (b) Notwithstanding Section 614.021(b), this section 17 applies to a fire fighter employed by a municipality regardless of 18 whether the municipality is covered by a meet and confer or 19 collective bargaining agreement under Chapter 143 or 174, Local 20 21 Government Code. 22 (c) In addition to the requirements of Section 614.023, a 23 municipality may not take punitive action against a fire fighter

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unless an investigation has been conducted in accordance with

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1 Section 143.123 or 143.312, Local Government Code, or other
2 applicable law.

3 <u>(d) A municipality to which Section 143.123 or 143.312,</u> 4 <u>Local Government Code, or another substantially similar</u> 5 <u>investigation requirement does not apply shall adopt and comply</u> 6 <u>with procedures substantially identical to those required by</u> 7 Section 143.312, Local Gov<u>ernment Code.</u>

8 SECTION 2. Section 614.023(a), Government Code, is amended 9 to read as follows:

10 (a) A copy of a signed complaint against a law enforcement 11 officer of this state or a fire fighter, detention officer, county 12 jailer, or peace officer appointed or employed by a political 13 subdivision of this state shall be given to the officer or employee:

14 <u>(1)</u> within a reasonable time after the complaint is 15 filed; or

16 (2) for a municipal fire fighter, in accordance with 17 procedures adopted under Section 614.024(d).

18 SECTION 3. Section 614.024, Government Code, as added by 19 this Act, applies only to an investigation, as that term is defined 20 by that section, initiated by a municipality on or after the 21 effective date of this Act.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
