5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 151.3565(b), Tax Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	(b) For purposes of this section, "emergency preparation
9	<pre>item" means:</pre>
10	(1) a portable generator used to provide light or
11	communications or to preserve perishable food in the event of a
12	power outage, the sales price of which is less than \$3,000;
13	(2) an item listed in this subdivision, the sales
14	price of which is less than \$300:
15	(A) a storm protection device manufactured,
16	rated, and marketed specifically to prevent damage to a glazed or
17	non-glazed opening during a storm; or
18	(B) an emergency or rescue ladder; or
19	(3) an item listed in this subdivision, the sales
20	price of which is less than \$75:
21	(A) a reusable or artificial ice product;
22	(B) a portable, self-powered light source;
23	(C) a gasoline or diesel fuel container;
24	(D) a AAA cell, AA cell, C cell, D cell, 6 volt,

- 1 or 9 volt battery, or a package containing more than one battery,
- 2 other than an automobile or boat battery;
- 3 (E) a nonelectric cooler or ice chest for food
- 4 storage;
- 5 (F) a tarpaulin or other flexible waterproof
- 6 sheeting;
- 7 (G) a ground anchor system or tie-down kit;
- 8 (H) a mobile telephone battery or battery
- 9 charger;
- 10 (I) a portable self-powered radio, including a
- 11 two-way radio or weatherband radio;
- 12 (J) a fire extinguisher, smoke detector, or
- 13 carbon monoxide detector;
- 14 (K) a hatchet or axe;
- 15 (L) a self-contained first aid kit; [or]
- 16 (M) a nonelectric can opener;
- 17 (N) a medical face mask or other face mask used to
- 18 protect the nose and mouth of a person wearing the mask from
- 19 potential contaminants in the environment or to interfere with the
- 20 transmission of particles originating from the nose or mouth of a
- 21 person wearing the mask, or a package containing more than one face
- 22 mask described by this paragraph;
- (0) a disposable glove, including a latex glove,
- 24 the primary purpose of which is to act as a protective barrier to
- 25 prevent the possible transmission of disease, or a package
- 26 containing more than one disposable glove described by this

- 1 (P) disinfectant cleaning supplies, including
- 2 bleach products and sanitizing wipes.
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 4 affect taxes imposed before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 5 law in effect before the effective date of this Act is continued in
- 6 effect for purposes of the liability for and collection of those
- 7 taxes.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
