4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended by adding Article 2.1387 to read as follows:
7	Art. 2.1387. INTERVENTION REQUIRED FOR EXCESSIVE FORCE;
8	REPORT REQUIRED. (a) A peace officer has a duty to intervene to
9	stop or prevent another peace officer from using excessive force
10	against a person suspected of committing an offense if an ordinary,
11	prudent peace officer would intervene under the same or similar
12	circumstances.
13	(b) A peace officer who witnesses the use of excessive force
14	by another peace officer shall promptly make a detailed report of
15	the incident and deliver the report to the supervisor of:
16	(1) the peace officer making the report; and
17	(2) the peace officer who used the excessive force.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
