## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to ballot language requirements for a proposition
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 274.001(b), Election Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) The proposition, whether prescribed by the <u>legislature</u>
- 8  $\underline{\text{or the}}$  secretary of state, must describe the proposed amendment in
- 9 plain language and [terms that] clearly express the effect of:
- 10 <u>(1)</u> approving the proposition;

proposing a constitutional amendment.

- 11 (2) failing to approve the proposition; or
- 12 (3) both approving the proposition and failing to
- 13 approve the proposition [its scope and character].
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An election ordered before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law in effect when the election is ordered, and the
- 18 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2022.
