AN ACT

2 relating to establishing actual progress for the purposes of 3 determining the right to repurchase real property from a condemning 4 entity.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 21.101, Property Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as 8 follows:

9 (b) In this section, "actual progress" means the completion 10 of <u>three</u> [two] or more of the following actions:

(1) the performance of a significant amount of labor to develop the property or other property acquired for the same public use project for which the property owner's property was acquired;

15 (2) the provision of a significant amount of materials 16 to develop the property or other property acquired for the same 17 public use project for which the property owner's property was 18 acquired;

(3) the hiring of <u>or contracting with</u> and <u>the</u> performance of a significant amount of work by an architect, engineer, or surveyor to prepare a plan, [or] plat, <u>or easement</u> that includes the property or other property acquired for the same public use project for which the property owner's property was acquired;

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(4) application for state or federal funds to develop
 the property or other property acquired for the same public use
 project for which the property owner's property was acquired; or

4 (5) application for a state or federal permit <u>or</u>
5 <u>certificate</u> to develop the property or other property acquired for
6 the same public use project for which the property owner's property
7 was acquired.

8 <u>(b-1)</u> Notwithstanding Subsection (b), a navigation district 9 or port authority, or a water district implementing a project 10 included in the state water plan adopted by the Texas Water 11 Development Board, may establish actual progress for purposes of 12 this section by:

13 (1) the completion of one action described by 14 <u>Subsection (b); and</u>

15 (2) [; (6) the acquisition of a tract or parcel of 16 real property adjacent to the property for the same public use 17 project for which the owner's property was acquired; or

18 [(7) for a governmental entity,] the adoption by a 19 majority of the entity's governing body at a public hearing of a 20 development plan for a public use project that indicates that the 21 entity will not complete more than one action described by 22 <u>Subsection (b)</u> [Subdivisions (1)-(6)] before the 10th anniversary 23 of the date of acquisition of the property.

SECTION 2. Section 21.101, Property Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a real property interest acquired in connection with a condemnation proceeding in which the petition is filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A real property

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1 interest acquired in connection with a condemnation proceeding in 2 which the petition is filed before the effective date of this Act is 3 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that 4 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
