A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to energy emergency alerts and notifications in the ERCOT
- 3 power region.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.918 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.918. ENERGY EMERGENCY ALERTS IN ERCOT POWER REGION.
- 8 (a) The commission shall require an independent organization
- 9 certified under Section 39.151 for the ERCOT power region to adopt
- 10 protocols to declare:
- 11 (1) an energy emergency alert level 1 when operating
- 12 <u>reserves are less than 4,600 megawatts and are not expected to</u>
- 13 <u>recover within 30 minutes;</u>
- 14 (2) an energy emergency alert level 2 when operating
- 15 reserves are less than 3,500 megawatts and are not expected to
- 16 recover within 30 minutes; and
- 17 (3) an energy emergency alert level 3 when operating
- 18 reserves are less than 2,000 megawatts and are not expected to
- 19 <u>recover within 30 minutes.</u>
- 20 (b) As soon as possible after an energy emergency alert is
- 21 declared or an alert level changes, the Texas Division of Emergency
- 22 Management shall request that the Federal Emergency Management
- 23 Agency issue a wireless emergency alert notifying residents of this
- 24 state of the declaration or change using mobile devices.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 418.196 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 418.196. PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION RELATING TO ENERGY
- 4 EMERGENCY ALERTS. (a) In this section, "state agency" means a
- 5 department, commission, board, office, council, authority, or
- 6 other agency in the executive branch of state government that is
- 7 created by the constitution or a statute of this state, including a
- 8 university system or institution of higher education as defined by
- 9 Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 10 (b) If an independent organization certified under Section
- 11 39.151, Utilities Code, for the ERCOT power region declares an
- 12 energy emergency alert, each state agency shall publish a
- 13 notification regarding the alert on the home page of the agency's
- 14 Internet website as soon as practicable.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
