- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 84.001, Election Code, is amended by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (e-1) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (e) Except as provided by Subsection (e-1), an application
- 8 [An applicant] for a ballot to be voted by mail serves as an
- 9 <u>application both</u> [may apply] for <u>a ballot</u> [ballots] for the main
- 10 election and <u>for</u> any resulting runoff election [on the same
- 11 $\frac{\text{application}}{\text{application}}$. If an application [for the main election and any
- 12 resulting runoff] is not timely for the main election, it will be
- 13 considered timely for any resulting runoff if received not later
- 14 than the deadline, determined using the date of the runoff
- 15 election, for submitting a regular application for a ballot to be
- 16 voted by mail.
- 17 <u>(e-1)</u> An applicant for a ballot to be voted by mail for the
- 18 main election may request not to receive a ballot for a resulting
- 19 runoff election.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
