1 the effective date of this Act. A lien for services provided before 2 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect 3 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is 4 continued in effect for that purpose.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
