4	SECTION 1. Section 662.003(b), Government Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(b) A state holiday includes only the following days:
7	(1) the 19th day of January, <u>"COVID-19 Heroes Day," in</u>
8	honor of the frontline workers, essential personnel, and all Texans
9	who sacrificed during the pandemic ["Confederate Heroes Day," in
10	honor of Jefferson Davis, Robert E. Lee, and other Confederate
11	heroes];
12	(2) the second day of March, "Texas Independence Day";
13	(3) the 21st day of April, "San Jacinto Day";
14	(4) the 19th day of June, "Emancipation Day in Texas,"
15	in honor of the emancipation of the slaves in Texas in 1865;
16	(5) the 27th day of August, "Lyndon Baines Johnson
17	Day," in observance of the birthday of Lyndon Baines Johnson;
18	(6) the Friday after Thanksgiving Day;
19	(7) the 24th day of December; and
20	(8) the 26th day of December.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
