A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to quarantine leave for fire fighters, peace officers,
3	detention officers, and emergency medical technicians employed by,
4	appointed by, or elected for a political subdivision.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 180, Local Government
7	Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 180. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AFFECTING OFFICERS AND
9	EMPLOYEES OF MORE THAN ONE TYPE OF [MUNICIPALITIES, COUNTIES, AND
10	CERTAIN OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENT [GOVERNMENTS]
11	SECTION 2. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended
12	by adding Section 180.008 to read as follows:
13	Sec. 180.008. QUARANTINE LEAVE FOR FIRE FIGHTERS, PEACE
14	OFFICERS, DETENTION OFFICERS, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS.
15	(a) In this section:
16	(1) "Detention officer" means an individual appointed
17	or employed by a political subdivision as a county jailer or other
18	individual responsible for the care and custody of individuals
19	incarcerated in a county or municipal jail.
20	(2) "Emergency medical technician" means an
21	<pre>individual who is:</pre>
22	(A) certified as an emergency medical technician
23	under Chapter 773, Health and Safety Code; and
24	(B) employed by a political subdivision.

- 1 (3) "Fire fighter" means a paid employee of a
- 2 municipal fire department or emergency services district who:
- 3 (A) holds a position that requires substantial
- 4 knowledge of fire fighting;
- 5 (B) has met the requirements for certification by
- 6 the Texas Commission on Fire Protection under Chapter 419,
- 7 Government Code; and
- 8 (C) performs a function listed in Section
- 9 143.003(4)(A).
- 10 (4) "Peace officer" means an individual described by
- 11 Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, who is elected for,
- 12 employed by, or appointed by a political subdivision.
- 13 (b) A political subdivision shall place on paid quarantine
- 14 leave a fire fighter, peace officer, detention officer, or
- 15 <u>emergency medical technician employed by the political subdivision</u>
- 16 and ordered by a supervisor or a health authority to quarantine or
- 17 isolate due to a possible or known exposure to a communicable
- 18 disease while on duty.
- 19 (c) A political subdivision shall provide to a fire fighter,
- 20 peace officer, detention officer, or emergency medical technician
- 21 <u>on quarantine leave:</u>
- (1) all employment benefits and compensation,
- 23 including leave accrual, pension benefits, and health benefit plan
- 24 benefits; and
- 25 (2) costs related to the quarantine, including
- 26 lodging, medical, and transportation costs.
- 27 (d) A political subdivision may not reduce a fire fighter's,

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- 1 peace officer's, detention officer's, or emergency medical
- 2 <u>technician's sick leave balance, vacation leave balance, holiday</u>
- 3 <u>leave</u> balance, or other paid leave balance in connection with
- 4 quarantine leave required by Subsection (b).
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
