5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 180, Local Government
7	Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 180. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AFFECTING OFFICERS AND
9	EMPLOYEES OF MORE THAN ONE TYPE OF [MUNICIPALITIES, COUNTIES, AND
10	CERTAIN OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENT [GOVERNMENTS]
11	SECTION 2. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended
12	by adding Section 180.008 to read as follows:
13	Sec. 180.008. QUARANTINE LEAVE FOR FIRE FIGHTERS, PEACE
14	OFFICERS, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS. (a) In this section:
15	(1) "Emergency medical technician" means an
16	<pre>individual who is:</pre>
17	(A) certified as an emergency medical technician
18	under Chapter 773, Health and Safety Code; and
19	(B) employed by a political subdivision.
20	(2) "Fire fighter" means a paid employee of a
21	municipal fire department or emergency services district who:
22	(A) holds a position that requires substantial
23	knowledge of fire fighting;
24	(B) has met the requirements for certification by

- 1 the Texas Commission on Fire Protection under Chapter 419,
- 2 Government Code; and
- 3 (C) performs a function listed in Section
- 4 143.003(4)(A).
- 5 (3) "Peace officer" means an individual described by
- 6 Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, who is elected for,
- 7 employed by, or appointed by a political subdivision.
- 8 (b) A political subdivision shall place on paid quarantine
- 9 leave a fire fighter, peace officer, or emergency medical
- 10 technician employed by the political subdivision and ordered by a
- 11 supervisor or a health authority to quarantine or isolate due to a
- 12 possible or known exposure to a communicable disease while on duty.
- 13 (c) A political subdivision shall provide to a fire fighter,
- 14 peace officer, or emergency medical technician on quarantine leave:
- 15 (1) all employment benefits and compensation,
- 16 including leave accrual, pension benefits, and health benefit plan
- 17 benefits; and
- 18 (2) costs related to the quarantine, including
- 19 lodging, medical, and transportation costs.
- 20 (d) A political subdivision may not reduce a fire fighter's,
- 21 peace officer's, or emergency medical technician's sick leave
- 22 <u>balance</u>, vacation leave balance, holiday leave balance, or other
- 23 paid leave balance in connection with quarantine leave required by
- 24 Subsection (b).
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
