- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 8506.056(d), (e), and (f), Special
- 6 District Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The board may employ a general manager. The general
- 8 <u>manager</u> [presiding officer] is the chief executive officer of the
- 9 authority. The general manager may not be a member of the board.
- 10 (e) The secretary, secretary pro tem, presiding officer,
- 11 general manager, and treasurer have the powers and duties, hold
- 12 office for the term, and are subject to removal in the manner
- 13 provided by the bylaws.
- 14 (f) The board shall set the compensation of the secretary,
- 15 secretary pro tem, presiding officer, general manager, and
- 16 treasurer.
- SECTION 2. Section 8506.058(c), Special District Local Laws
- 18 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 19 (c) The <u>general manager</u> [<u>presiding officer</u>] is in charge of
- 20 the authority's general office.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
