H.B. No. 2083

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to the general manager of the Upper Colorado River  
3 Authority.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 8506.056(d), (e), and (f), Special  
6 District Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows:

7 (d) The board may employ a general manager. The general  
8 manager [~~presiding officer~~] is the chief executive officer of the  
9 authority. The general manager may not be a member of the board.

10 (e) The secretary, secretary pro tem, presiding officer,  
11 general manager, and treasurer have the powers and duties, hold  
12 office for the term, and are subject to removal in the manner  
13 provided by the bylaws.

14 (f) The board shall set the compensation of the secretary,  
15 secretary pro tem, presiding officer, general manager, and  
16 treasurer.

17 SECTION 2. Section 8506.058(c), Special District Local Laws  
18 Code, is amended to read as follows:

19 (c) The general manager [~~presiding officer~~] is in charge of  
20 the authority's general office.

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
