6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Section 571.003(15), Health and Safety Code, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	(15) "Non-physician mental health professional"
10	means:

- 11 (A) a psychologist licensed to practice in this
- 12 state and designated as a health-service provider;
- 13 (B) a registered nurse with a master's or
- 14 doctoral degree in psychiatric nursing;
- 15 (C) a licensed clinical social worker;
- 16 (D) a licensed professional counselor licensed
- 17 to practice in this state; [er]
- 18 (E) a licensed marriage and family therapist
- 19 licensed to practice in this state; or
- 20 <u>(F) a physician assistant licensed to practice in</u>
- 21 <u>this state</u>.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
