12	shall collect monitoring data related to surface water and
13	groundwater and the integration of surface water and groundwater.
14	For purposes of this section, the bureau may collect data related to
15	soil or atmospheric moisture, if appropriate.
16	(b) The bureau shall use the data collected under Subsection
17	(a) to create a system of comprehensive surface water and
18	groundwater models, including models of the integration of surface
19	water and groundwater.
20	Sec. 39.0103. COOPERATION. As is necessary to carry out its
21	duties under this chapter, the bureau may cooperate with:
22	(1) Texas A&M University;
23	(2) Texas Tech University;

1 (4) a private entity. 2 Sec. 39.0104. RESULTS. The bureau shall make the results of the monitoring and modeling required by this chapter available to 3 4 state agencies and state institutions of higher education. 5 Sec. 39.0105. PUBLIC INFORMATION EXEMPTION. The data and models produced as required by this chapter are not subject to 6 disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code. 7 8
