- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.014, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (c) The secretary of state shall adopt rules that:
- 9 (1) require a device described by this section used
- 10 during the early voting period or under the countywide polling
- 11 place program under Section 43.007 to update data in real time; and
- 12 (2) require a county that uses a device described by
- 13 this section to use each device function described by Subsection
- 14 (a).
- 15 (d) If a county uses a device that does not comply with a
- 16 rule adopted under this section or uses a device in a manner that
- 17 does not comply with \underline{a} [the] rule $\underline{adopted}$ under this section in two
- 18 consecutive general elections for state and county officers, the
- 19 secretary of state shall assess a noncompliance fee. The
- 20 noncompliance fee shall be set at an amount determined by secretary
- 21 of state rule.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 23 an election that is ordered on or after the effective date of this
- 24 Act.
