## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the membership of the Public Utility Commission of
- 3 Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.051, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Section 12.051. APPOINTMENT; TERM. (a) The commission is
- 8 composed of five [three] commissioners appointed by the governor
- 9 with the advice and consent of the senate.
- 10 (b) The members shall be appointed to reflect the diverse
- 11 geographic regions and population groups of the state. One member
- 12 must reside in a rural area and be a registered voter of a county
- 13 with a population of less than 150,000.
- (c) [<del>(b)</del>] An appointment to the commission shall be made
- 15 without regard to the race, color, disability, sex, religion, age,
- 16 or national origin of the appointee.
- (d)  $[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$  Commissioners serve staggered, six-year terms,
- 18 with the terms of one or two members expiring every two years.
- 19 SECTION 2. Promptly after this Act takes effect, the
- 20 governor shall appoint two additional members to the Public Utility
- 21 Commission of Texas. Of those members, the governor shall
- 22 designate one to serve a term expiring September 1, 2025, and one to
- 23 serve a term expiring September 1, 2027.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
