- 2 relating to the administration of navigation districts.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 60.101, Water Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (d) A district may contract with a broker to sell or lease a
- 8 tract of land in the same manner as the commissioners court of a
- 9 county under Section 263.008, Local Government Code.
- 10 (e) A lease that requires the lessee to construct
- 11 improvements on land owned by the district is not a public work
- 12 contract for purposes of Chapter 2253, Government Code.
- SECTION 2. Sections 60.172(b), (c), and (d), Water Code,
- 14 are amended to read as follows:
- 15 (b) The commission shall fix a time and place at which a
- 16 public hearing concerning the proposed indebtedness shall be held.
- 17 The date of the hearing shall be not less than seven $[\frac{15}{2}]$ days nor
- 18 more than 30 days from the date of the resolution of the commission
- 19 giving [the] notice of the hearing date.
- 20 (c) Notice published by the commission under this section
- 21 shall:
- 22 (1) include a statement of the amount and purpose of
- 23 the proposed indebtedness;
- 24 (2) inform all persons of the time and place of

- 1 hearing; and
- 2 (3) inform all persons of their right to express their
- 3 views [appear] at the hearing, orally or in writing, and contend for
- 4 or protest the creation of the indebtedness.
- 5 (d) The secretary of the commission shall publish [post
- 6 copies of] the notice not earlier than the seventh day [for 10 days]
- 7 before the <u>date</u> [day] of the hearing:
- 8 <u>(1)</u> in a newspaper of general circulation in the
- 9 district's territory that is available to residents of the
- 10 district; or
- 11 (2) on the district's Internet website, in an area of
- 12 that website used to inform district residents about events such as
- 13 public meetings [three public places in the district and at the door
- 14 of each county courthouse located in the district].
- 15 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 60.405, Water Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 60.405. PROPOSAL PROCEDURES [COMPETITIVE SEALED
- 18 PROPOSALS].
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 60.172(e), Water Code, is repealed.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
