1-20 relating to the location of pits used in the production of oil and

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 91, Natural Resources
 1-24 Code, is amended by adding Section 91.1017 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 91.1017. LOCATION OF CERTAIN PITS. The commission by
 1-26 rule shall establish standards governing permissible locations for
 1-27 pits used by commercial oil and gas disposal facilities. The rules
 1-28 must include a history of flooding in the 10 years preceding the
 1-29 construction of the pit as a factor in determining whether a
 1-30 proposed location of a pit is permissible.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
