A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to charitable bingo.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Amend Section 2001.002(19), Occupations Code, to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (19) "Nonprofit organization" means an unincorporated
- 7 association or a corporation that is incorporated or holds a
- 8 certificate of authority under Chapter 22, Business Organizations
- 9 Code [the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act (Article 1396-1.01 et
- 10 seq., Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes)]. The organization:
- 11 (A) may not distribute any of its income to its
- 12 members, officers, or governing body, other than as reasonable
- 13 compensation for services; and
- 14 (B) must have obtained tax exempt status under
- 15 Section 501(c), Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
- SECTION 2. Amend Section 2001.103, Occupations Code, by
- 17 amending Subsections (e) and (f) and adding Subsection (i) to read
- 18 as follows:
- 19 (e) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), an authorized
- 20 organization that holds an annual license to conduct bingo may
- 21 receive not more than $48 \left[\frac{24}{2}\right]$ temporary licenses during the
- 22 12-month period following the issuance or renewal of the license.
- 23 The holder of a license that is effective for two years may receive
- 24 not more than 48 [24] temporary licenses for each 12-month period

- 1 that ends on an anniversary of the date the license was issued or
- 2 renewed.
- 3 (f) An authorized organization that holds a regular license
- 4 to conduct bingo may apply for all or any portion of the total
- 5 number of temporary licenses to which the organization is entitled
- 6 under Subsection (e) in one application without stating the days or
- 7 times for which the organization will use the temporary licenses.
- 8 The commission shall provide for the electronic issuance on demand
- 9 of all of the temporary licenses requested.
- 10 (i)(1) The commission shall provide for the electronic
- 11 issuance of all the temporary licenses requested by an annual
- 12 license holder as soon as practicable following approval of the
- 13 application.
- 14 (2) The commission is not required to notify a
- 15 municipality or county of the issuance of a temporary license to a
- 16 <u>non-annual license holder.</u>
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 2001.413, Occupations Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 2001.413. [ADMISSION CHARGE] PAYMENT REQUIRED. Except
- 20 as provided by Section 2001.4155, a licensed authorized
- 21 organization may not offer or provide to a person the opportunity to
- 22 play bingo without payment [charge].
- SECTION 4. Amend Sections 2001.416(a) and (d), Occupations
- 24 Code, to read as follows:
- (a) [A] Except as provided by Subsection (d), a game of
- 26 chance other than bingo or a raffle conducted under Chapter 2002 may
- 27 not be conducted or allowed during a bingo occasion.

- 1 (d) This section does not prohibit the exhibition and play
- 2 of:
- 3 (1) an amusement machine that is not a gambling device
- 4 as defined by Section 47.01, Penal Code; or
- 5 (2) any other game of chance that is conducted
- 6 lawfully and is not specifically prohibited to be conducted during
- 7 <u>a bingo occasion</u>.
- 8 SECTION 5. Section 2001.420, Occupations Code, is amended
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 2001.420. PRIZES. (a) [A bingo prize may not have a
- 11 value of more than \$750 for a single game.
- 12 [(b)] A person may not offer or award on a single bingo
- occasion prizes with an aggregate value of more than \$3500 [\$2,500]
- 14 for all bingo games other than:
- 15 (1) pull-tab bingo; or
- 16 (2) bingo games that award individual prizes of \$50 or
- 17 less.
- 18 [(c)] (b) A licensed authorized organization or other
- 19 person may not award or offer to award a door prize with a value of
- 20 more than \$250.
- [$\frac{d}{d}$] $\frac{d}{d}$ Notwithstanding any other law, a licensed
- 22 authorized organization may offer and award as a bingo prize under
- 23 this chapter a ticket for a charitable raffle conducted under
- 24 Chapter 2002. The bingo prize amount is the cost to purchase the
- 25 ticket to enter the charitable raffle for purposes of this chapter.
- SECTION 6. Amend Section 2001.435(b), Occupations Code, to
- 27 read as follows:

- 1 (b) Each member of a unit shall deposit into the unit's
- 2 bingo account all funds derived from the conduct of bingo, less the
- 3 amount awarded as cash prizes under Sections 2001.420(a) and (b).
- 4 The deposit shall be made not later than the [second] third business
- 5 day after the day of the bingo occasion on which the receipts were
- 6 obtained.
- 7 SECTION 7. Amend Sections 2001.451(g) and (i), Occupations
- 8 Code, to read as follows:
- 9 (g) The bingo operations of a licensed authorized
- 10 organization must[+
- 11 [(1) result in net proceeds over the organization's license
- 12 period; or
- 13 (2) if the organization has a two-year license,
- 14 result in net proceeds over each [12-month] 24-month period that
- 15 ends on $\underline{\text{the}}$ [an] anniversary of the date the [two-year] license was
- 16 issued.
- 17 (i) Prize fees held in escrow for remittance to the
- 18 commission and local governments, and prize fees retained by a
- 19 <u>licensed authorized organization</u>, are not included in the
- 20 calculation of operating capital under Subsection (h).
- 21 SECTION 8. Amend Section 2001.459(b), Occupations Code, to
- 22 read as follows:
- (b) Payment for a service under Subsection (a)(8) [(a)(10)]
- 24 may be paid from an organization's gross receipts.
- SECTION 9. Amend Sections 2001.502(b) and (c), Occupations
- 26 Code, to read as follows:
- (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a)(2), each quarter, a

- 1 licensed authorized organization or unit that collects a prize fee
- 2 under Subsection (a) for a bingo game conducted in a county or
- 3 municipality that was entitled to receive a portion of a bingo prize
- 4 fee as of January 1, 2019, shall remit 50 percent of the amount
- 5 collected as the prize fee to the commission and:
- 6 (1) remit 50 percent of the amount collected as the
- 7 prize fee to the county if the location at which the bingo game is
- 8 conducted is not within the boundaries of a municipality and the
- 9 county voted to impose the prize fee by November 1, 2019; [if the
- 10 county or municipality in which the bingo game is conducted voted
- 11 before November 1, 2019, to impose the prize fee, remit 50 percent
- 12 of the amount collected as the prize fee to:
- (A) the county that voted to impose the fee by
- 14 that date, provided the location at which the bingo game is
- 15 conducted is not within the boundaries of a municipality that voted
- 16 to impose the prize fee by that date;
- 17 (B) the municipality that voted to impose the fee
- 18 by that date, provided the county in which the bingo game is
- 19 conducted did not vote to impose the fee by that date; or
- (C) in equal shares, the county and the
- 21 municipality, provided each voted to impose the fee before that
- 22 date; or]
- 23 (2) remit 25 percent of the amount collected as the
- 24 prize fee to the county if the bingo game is conducted within the
- 25 boundaries of a municipality and the county voted to impose the
- 26 prize fee by November 1, 2019; [if neither the county or
- 27 municipality in which the bingo game is conducted voted before

- 1 November 1, 2019, to impose the prize fee, deposit the remainder of
- 2 the amount collected as the prize fee in the general charitable fund
- 3 of the organization or on a pro rata basis to the general funds of
- 4 the organizations comprising the unit, as applicable, to be used
- 5 for the charitable purposes of the organization or organizations]
- 6 (3) remit 25 percent of the amount collected as the
- 7 prize fee to the municipality if the bingo game is conducted within
- 8 the boundaries of a municipality that voted to impose the prize fee
- 9 by November 1, 2019; and
- 10 (4) deposit any remaining amount collected as the
- 11 prize fee in the general charitable fund of the organization or on a
- 12 pro rata basis to the general funds of the organizations comprising
- 13 the unit, as applicable, to be used for the charitable purposes of
- 14 the organization or organizations.
- 15 (c) The governing body of a county or municipality that
- 16 voted to impose a prize fee under Subsection (b) (b) (b) (b) may at any
- 17 time vote to discontinue the imposition of the fee. If a county or
- 18 municipality votes on or after November 1, 2019, to discontinue the
- 19 fee, the fees to which the county or municipality, as applicable,
- 20 was entitled before the vote shall be collected by the licensed
- 21 authorized organization or unit as defined by Section 2001.431 and
- 22 deposited as provided by Subsection (b)(4) $[\frac{(b)(2)}{2}]$.
- SECTION 10. Amend Section 2001.513(a), Occupations Code, to
- 24 read as follows:
- 25 (a) At any time within three years after a person is
- 26 delinquent in the payment of an amount of the fee on prizes due the
- 27 commission, the commission may collect the amount under this

- 1 section.
- 2 SECTION 11. 2001.514(a), Occupations Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 (a) To secure payment of the fee on prizes due the
- 5 commission imposed under this subchapter, each license holder shall
- 6 furnish to the commission:
- 7 (1) a cash bond;
- 8 (2) a bond from a surety company chartered or
- 9 authorized to do business in this state;
- 10 (3) certificates of deposit;
- 11 (4) certificates of savings;
- 12 (5) United States treasury bonds;
- 13 (6) subject to the approval of the commission, an
- 14 assignment of negotiable stocks or bonds; or
- 15 (7) other security as the commission considers
- 16 sufficient.
- 17 SECTION 12. Amend Section 2001.515, Occupations Code, to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 2001.515. COMMISSION'S DUTIES. The commission shall
- 20 perform all functions incident to the administration, collection,
- 21 enforcement, and operation of the fee on prizes <u>due the commission</u>
- 22 imposed under this subchapter, including any necessary
- 23 reconciliation of prize fees held by the commission that are due to
- 24 municipalities or counties.
- 25 SECTION 13. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
- 26 (b) The commission shall adopt such rules as may be needed
- 27 to administer the provisions of this Act to be effective no later
