1 would identify or tend to identify a person or household that 2 applies for <u>or receives disaster recovery assistance</u>, including 3 <u>utility payment assistance and</u> state or federal disaster recovery 4 funds.

5 [(c) The street name and census block group of and the 6 amount of disaster recovery funds awarded to a person or household 7 are not confidential after the date on which disaster recovery 8 funds are awarded to the person or household.]

9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
