- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 351, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 351.1069 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 351.1069. ALLOCATION OF REVENUE: CERTAIN
- 8 MUNICIPALITIES. In addition to other authorized uses, a
- 9 municipality described by Section 351.1066(a)(6) may use revenue
- 10 derived from the tax imposed under this chapter to promote tourism
- 11 by enhancing and upgrading an existing sports facility or field,
- 12 provided that the municipality complies with Section 351.1076.
- SECTION 2. Section 351.1076(a), Tax Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 (a) A municipality that spends municipal hotel occupancy
- 16 tax revenue for the enhancement and upgrading of existing sports
- 17 facilities or fields as authorized by Section 351.101(a)(7) or (n),
- 18 <u>Section 351.1069</u>, or Section 351.10711:
- 19 (1) shall determine the amount of municipal hotel
- 20 occupancy tax revenue generated for the municipality by hotel
- 21 activity attributable to the sports events and tournaments held on
- 22 the enhanced or upgraded facilities or fields for five years after
- 23 the date the enhancements and upgrades are completed; and
- 24 (2) may not spend hotel occupancy tax revenue for the

- 1 enhancement and upgrading of the facilities or fields in a total
- 2 amount that exceeds the amount of area hotel revenue attributable
- 3 to the enhancements and upgrades.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
