AN ACT

- 2 relating to the use of municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue by
 3 certain municipalities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 351, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 351.1069 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 351.1069. ALLOCATION OF REVENUE: CERTAIN
- 8 MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This section applies only to a municipality
- 9 <u>described by Section 351.1066(a)(6).</u>
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter and
- 11 in addition to other authorized uses, a municipality to which this
- 12 section applies may use all or any portion of the revenue from the
- 13 municipal hotel occupancy tax for:
- 14 (1) the construction and maintenance of a sports
- 15 facility; or

- 16 (2) the purchase or conversion of a building to serve
- 17 as a city hall and visitor center.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
