- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 433.006, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 433.006. <u>EXEMPTION FOR</u> PERSONAL USE <u>OR DONATION TO</u>
- 8 NONPROFIT FOOD BANK [EXEMPTION].
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 433.006(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The provisions of this chapter requiring inspection of
- 12 the slaughter of livestock and the preparation of carcasses, parts
- 13 of carcasses, meat, and meat food products at establishments
- 14 conducting those operations do not apply to the slaughtering of
- 15 livestock or the preparation and transportation in intrastate
- 16 commerce of those articles if:
- 17 (1) the articles are:
- 18 (A) livestock exclusively for personal use by the
- 19 owner of the livestock, a member of the owner's family, or a
- 20 nonpaying guest of the owner; or
- 21 (B) exotic animals exclusively for donation by a
- 22 hunter to a nonprofit food bank, as defined by Section 418.026(a),
- 23 Government Code;
- 24 (2) the slaughter or preparation is conducted at the

- 1 owner's premises, premises where the hunter killed the exotic
- 2 <u>animal</u>, or at a processing establishment; and
- 3 (3) the transportation is limited to moving the
- 4 carcasses, parts of carcasses, meat, and meat food products to and
- 5 from:
- 6 <u>(A)</u> the owner's premises and a processing
- 7 establishment; or
- 8 <u>(B) the premises where the hunter killed the</u>
- 9 exotic animal, the processing establishment, and the nonprofit food
- 10 <u>bank</u>.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 433.024(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) The department shall inspect each slaughtering
- 14 establishment whose primary business is the selling of livestock to
- 15 be slaughtered by the purchaser on premises owned or operated by the
- 16 seller. This subsection does not nullify the provisions in Section
- 17 433.006 relating to exemptions [personal use exemption].
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
