Section 433.006, Health and Safety Code, 9 is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to 10 11 read as follows: 12 (a) The provisions of this chapter requiring inspection of the slaughter of livestock and the preparation of carcasses, parts 13 14 of carcasses, meat, and meat food products at establishments conducting those operations do not apply to the slaughtering of 15 16 livestock or the preparation and transportation in intrastate commerce of those articles if: 17 18 (1) the articles are: (A) livestock exclusively for personal use by the 19 owner of the livestock, a member of the owner's family, or a 20 21 nonpaying guest of the owner; or 22 (B) exotic animals exclusively for donation by a 23 hunter to a nonprofit food bank, as defined by Section 418.026(a), 24 Government Code;

No. 2213 1 (2) the slaughter or preparation is conducted at the owner's premises, the premises where the hunter killed the exotic 2 3 animal, or at a processing establishment; and 4 (3) the transportation is limited to moving the 5 carcasses, parts of carcasses, meat, and meat food products to and 6 from: 7 (A) the owner's premises and a processing 8 establishment; or 9 (B) the premises where the hunter killed the exotic animal, the processing establishment, and the nonprofit food 10 bank. 11 12 (d) An article described by Subsection (a)(1)(B) may not be 13 combined with: 14 (1) a meat food product regulated under the Federal 15 Meat Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section 601 et seq.); or 16 (2) a poultry product regulated under the federal 17 Poultry Products Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section 451 et seq.). SECTION 3. Section 433.024(b), Health and Safety Code, is 18 amended to read as follows: 19 department shall 20 (b) The inspect each slaughtering establishment whose primary business is the selling of livestock to 21 be slaughtered by the purchaser on premises owned or operated by the 22 23 seller. This subsection does not nullify the provisions in Section 24 433.006 relating to exemptions [personal use exemption]. SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 25
