A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a study by the Texas Department of Transportation on the
- 3 impact of certain classifications of motor vehicle on the roads and
- bridges of this state. 4

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "department" means the 6
- 7 Texas Department of Transportation.
- SECTION 2. STUDY AND REPORT. (a) 8 The department, in
- consultation with the Texas A&M Transportation Institute, The 9
- University of Texas Center for Transportation Research, 10
- 11 transportation industry representatives, shall conduct a study on
- 12 the impact on the roads and bridges of this state by motor vehicles
- classified as: 13
- 14 (1) passenger vehicles;
- (2) commercial motor vehicles; and 15
- oversize or overweight vehicles. 16
- The study shall determine, for each classification of 17
- vehicle listed in Subsection (a) of this section: 18
- (1) the number of vehicles that drive on the roads and 19
- 20 bridges of this state each year;
- 21 (2) the number of miles driven on the roads and bridges
- 22 of this state each year;
- (3) the total revenue contribution from taxes and fees 23
- 24 to the construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges of this

- 1 state;
- 2 (4) the financial impact due to costs associated with:
- 3 (A) construction and maintenance of the roads and
- 4 bridges of this state; and
- 5 (B) congestion on the roads and bridges of this
- 6 state; and
- 7 (5) whether and by what amount the total revenue
- 8 contribution determined under Subdivision (3) of this subsection
- 9 exceeds or falls short of the financial impact determined under
- 10 Subdivision (4) of this subsection.
- 11 (c) The study shall recommend one or more changes to
- 12 existing tax or fee structures to ensure that vehicles of each
- 13 classification listed under Subsection (a) of this section
- 14 contribute revenue to fund the construction and maintenance of the
- 15 roads and bridges of this state in an amount at least equal to the
- 16 financial impact of the vehicles of that classification on those
- 17 roads and bridges. The recommendations shall include:
- 18 (1) specific dollar amounts for taxes and fees for
- 19 each classification of vehicle; and
- 20 (2) if applicable, new methods of structuring existing
- 21 sources of revenue.
- 22 (d) Not later than November 1, 2022, the department shall
- 23 submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the
- 24 legislature a written report on the findings of the study. The
- 25 report must include recommendations for policy and statutory
- 26 changes, including any proposed legislation, that are based on the
- 27 results of the study.

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- 1 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION. This Act expires May 1, 2023.
- 2 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 3 1, 2021.
