4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 39.056 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 39.056. LANDOWNER PETITION TO TRANSFER TERRITORY TO
8	COMPETITIVE RETAIL MARKET. (a) The owner of a parcel of land part
9	of which is in an area open to competition in ERCOT and part of which
10	is in the certificated service area of an electric cooperative
11	created under Chapter 161 may petition the commission to:
12	(1) partition the part of the land that is subject to
13	the electric cooperative's certificate of convenience and
14	necessity;
15	(2) transfer the land described by Subdivision (1) to
16	the certificated service area of a transmission and distribution
17	utility that serves the part of the land that is in the area open to
18	competition; and
19	(3) amend accordingly the certificate of convenience
20	and necessity of the:
21	(A) electric cooperative; and
22	(B) transmission and distribution utility.
23	(b) The petition must provide the commission with an
24	accurate description of the land as necessary to facilitate the

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1 requested action.

2 (c) The commission shall hold a hearing on the petition. If the commission determines the partition and transfer of territory 3 is in the best interest of ratepayers, the commission shall approve 4 5 the partition and conduct a proceeding to effectuate the transfer. 6 (d) Through the proceeding, the commission shall determine the net book value of all of the cooperative's electric 7 distribution assets attributable to the service area that is 8 proposed to be transferred. 9 10 (e) Not later than the 90th day after the date the commission determines the value of the cooperative's electric 11 12 distribution assets attributable to the transferred service area, the transmission and distribution utility shall compensate the 13 14 cooperative for the assets as directed by the commission. 15 (f) The commission shall amend or issue certificates of convenience and necessity to implement the transfer of the service 16 17 area. (g) The commission shall adopt rules to implement this 18 19 section.

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
