## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to health benefit plan coverage for colon cancer screening
- 3 for certain individuals.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1363.003(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A health benefit plan that provides coverage for
- 8 screening medical procedures must provide [<del>to each individual</del>
- 9 enrolled in the plan who is 50 years of age or older and at normal
- 10 risk for developing colon cancer] coverage for expenses incurred in
- 11 conducting a medically recognized screening examination for the
- 12 detection of colorectal cancer to each individual enrolled in the
- 13 plan who is 45 years of age or older.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 16 renewed on or after January 1, 2022. A health benefit plan that is
- 17 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2022,
- 18 is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 19 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 20 that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
