- 6 SECTION 1. Section 45.102, Family Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (c) A petitioner is not required to provide the street 8
- 9 address of the petitioner's place of residence or the petitioner's
- reason for the requested change of name as otherwise required by 10
- Subsection (a) if the petitioner provides a copy of an 11
- authorization card certifying in accordance with Article 58.059, 12
- Code of Criminal Procedure, that the petitioner is a participant in 13
- 14 the address confidentiality program administered by the attorney
- general under Subchapter B, Chapter 58, Code of Criminal Procedure. 15
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 45.103, Family Code, is amended by
- adding Subsections (a-1) and (c-1) to read as follows: 17
- 18 (a-1) For purposes of Subsection (a), it is presumed that a
- change of name is in the interest or to the benefit of the 19
- petitioner and in the interest of the public if the petitioner 20
- provides a copy of an authorization card certifying in accordance 21
- with Article 58.059, Code of Criminal Procedure, that the 22
- 23 petitioner is a participant in the address confidentiality program

- 2 (c-1) An order issued under this section to change the name
- 3 of a petitioner described by Subsection (a-1) is confidential and
- 4 may not be released by the court to any person, regardless of
- 5 whether the petitioner continues to participate in the address
- 6 confidentiality program following the change of name under this
- 7 <u>subchapter</u>.
- 8 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to a petition for a change of name that is submitted on or after the
- 10 effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
