A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the Texas Real Estate Research Center, the Real Estate
- 3 Research Advisory Committee, and the Texas Real Estate Commission;
- 4 increasing a fee.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter C, Chapter 86,
- 7 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER C. TEXAS REAL ESTATE RESEARCH CENTER
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 86.51, Education Code, is amended to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 86.51. TEXAS REAL ESTATE RESEARCH CENTER. The Texas
- 12 Real Estate Research Center [There] is established at Texas A&M
- 13 University [a Real Estate Research Center, hereinafter referred to
- 14 as the center]. The operating budget, staffing, and activities of
- 15 the center shall be approved by the board of regents of The Texas
- 16 A&M University System.
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 86.52, Education Code, is amended by
- 18 amending Subsections (c), (d), (e), (f), (h), (i), (j), (k), and (l)
- 19 and adding Subsection (m) to read as follows:
- 20 (c) Members [Except for the initial appointees, members] of
- 21 the advisory committee hold office for staggered terms of six
- 22 years, with the terms of three members expiring on January 31 of
- 23 each odd-numbered year. [In making the initial appointments, the
- 24 governor shall designate three members, including two

- 1 representatives of the real estate industry and one representative
- 2 of the general public, for terms expiring in 1973, three for terms
- 3 expiring in 1975, and three for terms expiring in 1977. Any
- 4 vacancy shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired portion of
- 5 the term. Each member shall serve until the member's [his]
- 6 successor is qualified.
- 7 (d) The <u>presiding officer</u> [chairman] of the Texas Real
- 8 Estate Commission, or a member of the commission designated by $\underline{\text{the}}$
- 9 presiding officer [him], shall serve as an ex officio, nonvoting
- 10 member of the advisory committee.
- 11 (e) The <u>advisory</u> committee shall elect a presiding officer
- 12 and an assistant presiding officer from the committee's [its]
- 13 membership, and each officer shall serve for a term of one year.
- 14 (f) [The first meeting of the advisory committee shall be
- 15 called by the president of Texas A & M University or his designated
- 16 representative.] The advisory committee shall meet not less than
- 17 semiannually, and in addition on call of the committee's presiding
- 18 officer [its chairman], or on petition of any six of the committee's
- 19 [its] members, or on call of the president of Texas A&M [A & M]
- 20 University or the president's [his] designated representative.
- 21 (h) The president of Texas $\underline{A\&M}$ [$\underline{A\&M}$] University or \underline{the}
- 22 <u>president's</u> [his] designated representative shall submit to the
- 23 advisory committee in advance of each fiscal year a proposed budget
- 24 for expenditures of all funds provided for the center in a form that
- 25 is related to the proposed schedule of activities for the review and
- 26 approval of the advisory committee. The proposed budget approved
- 27 by the advisory committee shall be forwarded with the comments of

- 1 the committee to the board of directors of The Texas $\underline{A\&M}$ [\underline{A} & \underline{M}]
- 2 University System prior to its action on the proposed budget, and
- 3 the board of directors of The Texas A&M [A & M] University System
- 4 shall not authorize any expenditure that has not had the prior
- 5 approval of the advisory committee.
- 6 (i) The president of Texas $\underline{A\&M}$ [$\underline{A\&M}$] University or \underline{the} 7 president's [\underline{his}] designated representative shall submit to the
- 8 advisory committee for its review and approval a research agenda at
- 9 the beginning of each fiscal year and shall continuously inform the
- 10 advisory committee of changes in its substance and scheduling.
- 11 (j) Each member of the <u>advisory committee</u> [board] is
- 12 entitled to a per diem as provided in the center's budget [set by
- 13 legislative appropriation for each day that the member engages in
- 14 the business of the committee [board]. A member may not receive any
- 15 compensation for travel expenses, including expenses for meals and
- 16 lodging, other than transportation expenses. A member is entitled
- 17 to compensation for transportation expenses as provided in
- 18 [prescribed by] the center's budget [General Appropriations Act].
- (k) Except as provided by Subsection (1), the [The] advisory
- 20 committee is subject to Chapter 551, Government Code, Chapter 2001,
- 21 Government Code, and the provisions of Chapter 572, Government
- 22 Code.
- 23 (1) The advisory committee may conduct a meeting by
- 24 conference call or virtually through a third-party Internet
- 25 application as long as members of the general public are able to
- 26 participate in the meeting, and any discussions during the meeting,
- 27 if the meeting is not permitted to be conducted as a closed meeting

- 1 under Chapter 551, Government Code.
- 2 (m) The financial transactions of the center are subject to
- 3 audit by the state auditor in accordance with Chapter 321,
- 4 Government Code.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 1101.054, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1101.054. OFFICIAL OATH. Not later than the 15th
- 8 calendar day after the date of appointment, each appointee must
- 9 take the constitutional oath of office.
- SECTION 5. Section 1101.154(a), Occupations Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) The fee for the issuance or renewal of a:
- 13 (1) broker license is the amount of the fee set under
- 14 Section 1101.152 and an additional \$70 fee for each year of the term
- 15 for which the license is issued or renewed;
- 16 (2) sales agent license is the amount of the fee set
- 17 under Section 1101.152 and an additional \$20 fee for each year of
- 18 the term for which the license is issued or renewed; and
- 19 (3) certificate of registration is the amount of the
- 20 fee set under Section 1101.152 and an additional \$20 fee for each
- 21 year of the term for which the certificate is issued or renewed.
- 22 SECTION 6. Section 1101.154(a), Occupations Code, as
- 23 amended by this Act, applies only to the issuance or renewal of a
- 24 license or certificate of registration under Chapter 1101,
- 25 Occupations Code, on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
