A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the denial of the registration of a motor vehicle based
- 3 on certain information provided by a county to the Texas Department
- 4 of Motor Vehicles.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 502.010, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsections (a), (b), (c), (d), (f), and (f-1) and
- 8 adding Subsections (a-1) and (k) to read as follows:
- 9 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a county
- 10 assessor-collector [or the department] may refuse to register a
- 11 motor vehicle if the assessor-collector [or the department]
- 12 receives information that the owner of the vehicle:
- 13 (1) owes the county money for a fine, fee, or tax that
- 14 is past due; or
- 15 (2) failed to appear in connection with a complaint,
- 16 citation, information, or indictment in a court in the county in
- 17 which a criminal proceeding is pending against the owner.
- 18 <u>(a-1)</u> If the department determines that a county
- 19 assessor-collector is authorized to refuse to register a vehicle
- 20 <u>under Subsection (a):</u>
- 21 (1) the vehicle may not be registered through an
- 22 online system designated by the department under Section
- 23 520.005(d); and
- 24 (2) the department shall refuse to register the

- 1 vehicle through an online system that is available to the public.
- 2 (b) The [A county may contract with the] department shall
- 3 <u>develop</u> and <u>implement</u> a system through which counties may [to]
- 4 provide information to the department necessary to make a
- 5 determination under Subsection (a-1) $[\frac{(a)}{(a)}]$. The system developed
- 6 under this section must:
- 7 (1) verify in real time the information described by
- 8 Subsection (a) by searching against the vehicle owner's driver's
- 9 license number, date of birth, or other information provided to the
- 10 department; and
- 11 (2) be used for the registration of a vehicle
- 12 <u>conducted through the department's Internet website.</u>
- 13 (c) A county that <u>provides information</u> [has a contract]
- 14 under Subsection (b) shall immediately notify the department
- 15 regarding a person for whom the county assessor-collector or the
- 16 department has refused to register a motor vehicle on:
- 17 (1) the person's payment or other means of discharge,
- 18 including a waiver, of the past due fine, fee, or tax; or
- 19 (2) perfection of an appeal of the case contesting
- 20 payment of the fine, fee, or tax.
- 21 (d) After notice is received under Subsection (c), the
- 22 county assessor-collector or the department may not refuse to
- 23 register the motor vehicle under Subsection (a) or (a-1).
- 24 (f) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a county
- 25 [that has a contract under Subsection (b)] may impose an additional
- 26 reimbursement fee of \$20 to:
- 27 (1) a person who fails to pay a fine, fee, or tax to the

- 1 county by the date on which the fine, fee, or tax is due; or
- 2 (2) a person who fails to appear in connection with a
- 3 complaint, citation, information, or indictment in a court in which
- 4 a criminal proceeding is pending against the owner.
- 5 (f-1) The additional reimbursement fee may be used only to
- 6 reimburse [the department or] the county assessor-collector for its
- 7 expenses for providing services under this section [the contract],
- 8 or another county department for expenses related to services under
- 9 this section [the contract].
- 10 (k) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
- 11 department:
- 12 (1) may collect information necessary to implement
- 13 this section, including a vehicle owner's driver's license number
- 14 or date of birth; and
- 15 (2) may not disclose any personal identifying
- 16 <u>information collected under this section</u>, including a vehicle
- 17 owner's driver's license number or date of birth.
- SECTION 2. Section 502.010(e), Transportation Code, is
- 19 repealed.
- 20 SECTION 3. The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles shall
- 21 implement the system required by Section 502.010(b),
- 22 Transportation Code, as amended by this Act, not later than
- 23 September 1, 2022.
- SECTION 4. Section 502.010, Transportation Code, as amended
- 25 by this Act, applies only to an application for motor vehicle
- 26 registration or registration renewal received by the Texas
- 27 Department of Motor Vehicles on or after the effective date of this

- 1 Act. An application for registration or registration renewal that
- 2 was received before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 3 the law in effect on the date the application was received, and the
- 4 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 5. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 6 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2022.
- 7 (b) Section 3 of this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
