A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a COVID-19 vaccine public awareness campaign. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 161, Health and Safety 4 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 161.01015 to read as follows: Sec. 161.01015. COVID-19 VACCINE PUBLIC AWARENESS 6 CAMPAIGN. (a) In this section, "COVID-19" means the 2019 novel 7 8 coronavirus. (b) The department shall develop and implement a public 9 awareness campaign designed to increase awareness of and educate 10 the public concerning the safety and effectiveness of COVID-19 11 vaccines that are approved or authorized for emergency use by the 12 United States Food and Drug Administration. 13 14 (c) In implementing the campaign, the department shall seek to disseminate scientific and evidence-based information and 15 combat misinformation, with the goal of increasing vaccination 16 17 rates, particularly in communities with low rates of vaccination. (d) The department may pay the costs of the program and its 18 19 administration from: 20 (1) gifts, grants, or donations; 21 (2) federal funds; and 22 (3) any other money made available for that purpose, 23 including money specifically appropriated for the campaign and any 24 other available department revenue.

1 (e) This section expires September 1, 2023.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
