5 SECTION 1. Section 87.027(i), Election Code, is amended to

7 The signature verification committee shall compare the signature on each carrier envelope certificate, except those signed 8 9 for a voter by a witness, with the signature on the voter's ballot application to determine whether the signatures are those of the 10 11 The committee shall also compare the signatures with each 12 signature of the voter obtained from the Department of Public Safety and on file with the county clerk or voter registrar. The 13 14 committee may also compare the signatures with any two or more signatures of the voter made within the preceding six years and on 15 file with the county clerk or voter registrar to determine whether 16 the signatures are those of the voter. Except as provided by 17 Subsection (1), a determination under this subsection that the 18 signatures are not those of the voter must be made by a majority 19 vote of the committee's membership. The committee shall place the 20 21 jacket envelopes, carrier envelopes, and applications of voters whose signatures are not those of the voter in separate containers 22 23 from those of voters whose signatures are those of the voter. The committee chair shall deliver the sorted materials to the early 24

- 3 SECTION 2. Section 87.041, Election Code, is amended by
- 4 adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 5 (e-1) In making the determination under Subsection (b)(2),
- 6 the board shall also compare the signatures with each signature of
- 7 the voter obtained from the Department of Public Safety and on file
- 8 with the county clerk or voter registrar.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
