2 relating to the assessment of writing performance for public school

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (h-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (h-1) Notwithstanding any other provision in this section,
- 8 for a reading assessment instrument administered under Subsection
- 9 (a) or an English I or English II end-of-course assessment
- 10 <u>instrument administered under Subsection (c)</u>, the portion of the
- 11 assessment instrument that is not presented in a multiple choice
- 12 <u>format may be used as part of a classroom portfolio method to assess</u>
- 13 writing performance. The commissioner shall adopt rules to allow
- 14 that portion of the assessment instrument to be scored by a
- 15 classroom teacher assigned to the same campus as the student to whom
- 16 the assessment instrument is administered.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
