5	SECTION 1. Section 30.05(d), Penal Code, is amended to read
6	as follows:
7	(d) An offense under this section is:
8	(1) a Class B misdemeanor, except as provided by
9	Subdivisions (2) and (3);
10	(2) a Class C misdemeanor, except as provided by
11	Subdivision (3), if the offense is committed:
12	(A) on agricultural land and within 100 feet of
13	the boundary of the land; or
14	(B) on residential land and within 100 feet of a
15	protected freshwater area; and
16	(3) a Class A misdemeanor if:
17	(A) the offense is committed:
18	(i) in a habitation or a shelter center;
19	(ii) on a Superfund site; or
20	(iii) on or in a critical infrastructure
21	facility;
22	(B) [the offense is committed on or in property
23	of an institution of higher education and] it is shown on the trial
24	of the offense that the person has previously been convicted of:

- 1 (i) an offense under this section [relating
- 2 to entering or remaining on or in property of an institution of
- 3 higher education]; or
- 4 (ii) an offense under Section 51.204(b)(1),
- 5 Education Code, relating to trespassing on the grounds of an
- 6 institution of higher education; or
- 7 (C) the person carries a deadly weapon during the
- 8 commission of the offense.
- 9 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 10 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 11 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 12 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 13 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 14 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 15 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
- 16 date.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
