## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the participation by local governments in water quality
- 3 control measures.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 26.0151, Water Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (d-1) The commission shall establish and maintain an
- 8 electronic portal for local governments to access:
- 9 (1) information provided under Subsection (a); and
- 10 (2) any discharge monitoring report received by the
- 11 commission.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 26.017, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 13 follows:
- 14 Sec. 26.017. COOPERATION. The commission shall:
- 15 (1) encourage voluntary cooperation by the people,
- 16 cities, counties, industries, associations, agricultural
- 17 interests, and representatives of other interests in preserving the
- 18 greatest possible utility of water in the state;
- 19 (2) encourage the formation and organization of
- 20 cooperative groups, associations, cities, counties, industries,
- 21 and other water users for the purpose of providing a medium to
- 22 discuss and formulate plans for attainment of water quality
- 23 control;
- 24 (3) establish policies and procedures for securing

- 1 close cooperation among state agencies that have water quality
- 2 control functions;
- 3 (4) cooperate with the governments of the United
- 4 States and other states and with official or unofficial agencies
- 5 and organizations with respect to water quality control matters and
- 6 with respect to formulation of interstate water quality control
- 7 compacts or agreements, and when representation of state interests
- 8 on a basin planning agency for water quality purposes is required
- 9 under Section 3(c) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as
- 10 amended, or other federal legislation having a similar purpose, the
- 11 representation shall include an officer or employee of the
- 12 commission; and
- 13 (5) with respect to obtaining or administering the
- 14 NPDES program in lieu of the government of the United States, not
- 15 enter into any memorandum of agreement or other contractual
- 16 relationship with or among state agencies or with the government of
- 17 the United States which imposes any requirements upon the state
- 18 other than or more stringent than those specifically set forth in
- 19 Section 402(b) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as
- 20 amended.
- 21 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 22 of this Act, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality shall
- 23 establish the electronic portal required by Section 26.0151(d-1),
- 24 Water Code, as added by this Act.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
