A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to efficiency audits of the Department of Family and
- 3 Protective Services.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 40, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 40.045 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 40.045. EFFICIENCY AUDIT. (a) For purposes of this
- 8 section, "efficiency audit" means an investigation of the
- 9 operations of the department to examine fiscal management,
- 10 efficiency, outcomes for children and families served by the
- 11 department, and utilization of resources.
- 12 (b) During the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2022, and
- 13 every fourth year after that date, the department shall conduct an
- 14 efficiency audit.
- 15 (c) In a year in which an efficiency audit is completed as
- 16 required by this section, the efficiency audit shall satisfy the
- 17 department's annual internal audit requirements under Chapter
- 18 2102, Government Code.
- 19 <u>(d) The department shall pay the costs associated with an</u>
- 20 efficiency audit required under this section using money
- 21 appropriated for administrative and internal audit operations in
- 22 the state fiscal year the audit is conducted.
- (e) If the department fails to conduct an efficiency audit
- 24 as required by this section, the amount appropriated to the

- 1 department by the legislature for the next state fiscal biennium
- 2 may not exceed the department's baseline budget.
- 3 (f) Not later than March 1 of the state fiscal year in which
- 4 an efficiency audit is required under this section, the
- 5 commissioner, in collaboration with the council, the department's
- 6 chief financial officer, and the department's internal audit
- 7 director, shall select an external auditor to conduct the
- 8 efficiency audit.
- 9 <u>(g) The external auditor shall be independent of the</u>
- 10 department's direction.
- 11 (h) The external auditor shall complete the audit not later
- 12 than the 90th day after the date the auditor is selected.
- 13 (i) The Legislative Budget Board shall establish the scope
- 14 of the efficiency audit and determine the areas of investigation
- 15 for the audit, including:
- 16 (1) reviewing the department's resources to determine
- 17 whether they are being used effectively and efficiently to achieve
- 18 desired outcomes for children and families served by the
- 19 department;
- 20 (2) identifying cost savings or reallocations of
- 21 resources; and
- 22 (3) identifying opportunities for improving services
- 23 through consolidation of essential functions, outsourcing, and
- 24 elimination of duplicative efforts.
- 25 <u>(j) Not later than November 1 of the calendar year an</u>
- 26 efficiency audit is conducted, the auditor shall prepare and submit
- 27 a report of the audit and recommendations for efficiency

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- 1 improvements to the governor, the Legislative Budget Board, the
- 2 state auditor, the commissioner, the council, and the chairs of the
- 3 House Human Services Committee and the Senate Health and Human
- 4 <u>Services Committee.</u>
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
