- 3 (b) Not later than December 31, 2021, the commission shall
- 4 transfer not less than \$300,000 from the real estate inspection
- 5 recovery fund to the general revenue fund.
- 6 (c) Not later than August 31, 2024, the commission shall
- 7 determine the remaining liability of the real estate inspection
- 8 recovery fund based on any pending claims for payment under former

- 11 Subsection (c) of this section, the commission shall refund to each

- SECTION 7. (a) Section 1102.114, Occupations Code, as
- 25 amended by this Act, applies only to an application for an inspector
- 26 license submitted to the Texas Real Estate Commission on or after
- 27 the effective date of this Act. An application for a license

- 1 submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 2 law in effect on the date the application was submitted, and the
- 3 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 (b) Sections 1101.603 and 1102.403, Occupations Code, as
- 5 amended by this Act, apply only to an administrative penalty that is
- 6 collected on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 7 administrative penalty that is collected before the effective date
- 8 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 9 administrative penalty was collected, and the former law is
- 10 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 11 (c) Subject to Subsection (d) of this section, the repeal by
- 12 this Act of Subchapter H, Chapter 1102, Occupations Code, does not
- 13 affect the validity of a claim for payment from the real estate
- 14 inspection recovery fund based on a cause of action that accrues
- 15 before the effective date of this Act. A claim for payment from the
- 16 fund based on a cause of action that accrues before the effective
- 17 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 18 cause of action accrued, and the former law is continued in effect
- 19 for that purpose.
- 20 (d) A claim for payment from the real estate inspection
- 21 recovery fund under former Section 1102.355, Occupations Code, for
- 22 a cause of action that accrues before the effective date of this Act
- 23 must be filed before March 1, 2024.
- SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
