19	<u>(3)</u> [and
20	$\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ a felony of the first degree if $\left[\frac{it}{it}\right]$ is shown on the

22	that contains 200 or more visual depictions of a child as described

1	(d-1) If it is shown on the trial of an offense under
2	Subsection (a) that the defendant has been previously convicted of
3	an offense under that subsection:
4	(1) an offense described for purposes of punishment by
5	Subsection (d)(1) or (2) is increased to the next higher category of
6	offense; or
7	(2) the minimum term of confinement for an offense
8	described for purposes of punishment by Subsection (d)(3) is
9	increased to 15 years.
10	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
11	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
12	An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
13	governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
14	and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
15	purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
16	effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
17	before that date.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
