- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 38, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 38.0015 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 38.0015. RECOVERY OF ATTORNEY'S FEES AS COMPENSATORY
- 8 DAMAGES. (a) A person may recover reasonable attorney's fees from
- 9 <u>an individual, corporation, or other entity from which recovery is</u>
- 10 permitted under Section 38.001 as compensatory damages for breach
- 11 of a construction contract as defined by Section 130.001.
- 12 (b) This section may not be construed to create or imply a
- 13 private cause of action or independent basis to recover attorney's
- 14 fees.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 17 this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
