4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 12, Penal Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 12.501 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 12.501. PENALTY IF OFFENSE COMMITTED DURING A RIOT.
8	(a) In this section, "riot" has the meaning assigned by Section
9	42.02.
10	(b) Subject to Subsections (d) and (e), the punishment for
11	an offense listed under Subsection (c) is increased to the
12	punishment prescribed for the next higher category of offense if it
13	is shown on the trial of the offense that at the time of the offense
14	the actor was participating in a riot.
15	(c) The increase in punishment authorized by this section
16	applies only to an offense under:
17	(1) Section 22.01;
18	(2) Section 28.02;
19	(3) Section 28.03;
20	(4) Section 29.02;
21	(5) Section 30.02;
22	(6) Section 30.03;
23	(7) Section 30.04;
24	(8) Section 30.05; and

- 1 (9) Section 31.03.
- 2 (d) If an offense listed under Subsection (c) is punishable
- 3 as a Class A misdemeanor, the minimum term of confinement for the
- 4 offense is increased to 180 days.
- 5 (e) If an offense listed under Subsection (c) is punishable
- 6 as a felony of the first degree, the punishment of that offense may
- 7 <u>not be increased under this section.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 10 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 11 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 12 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 13 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 14 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 15 before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
