Section 478.0051(b)(1) does not apply to an event described by Section 26 478.0001(3)(G) or (W). If an endorsing municipality or endorsing 27

1 county requests the office to make a determination under Section 2 478.0102 for an event described by Section 478.0001(3)(G) or (W), 3 the remaining provisions of this chapter apply to that event as if 4 the event satisfied the eligibility requirements under Section 5 478.0051(b)(1).

6 SECTION 3. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails 7 over another Act of the 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021, 8 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted 9 codes.
