- 3 the commissioners court in certain counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 28A, Water Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 28A. REGULATION [REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION] OF CERTAIN
- 8 AGGREGATE PRODUCTION OPERATIONS
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 28A.001(1), Water Code, is amended to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 (1) "Aggregate production operation" means the site
- 12 from which aggregates are being or have been removed or extracted
- 13 from the earth, including the entire areas of extraction, stripped
- 14 areas, haulage ramps, and the land on which the plant processing the
- 15 raw materials is located, exclusive of any land owned or leased by
- 16 the responsible party not being currently used in the production of
- 17 aggregates. For the purposes of this chapter, the term "aggregate
- 18 production operation" includes a quarry producing aggregates. For
- 19 the purposes of this chapter, the term "aggregate production
- 20 operation" does not include:
- 21 (A) a site at which the materials that are being
- 22 removed or extracted from the earth are used or processed at the
- 23 same site or at a related site under the control of the same
- 24 responsible party for the production of cement or lightweight

- 1 aggregates, or in a lime kiln;
- 2 (B) a temporary site that is being used solely to
- 3 provide aggregate products for use in a public works project
- 4 involving the Texas Department of Transportation or a local
- 5 governmental entity;
- 6 (C) an extraction area from which all raw
- 7 material is extracted for use as fill or for other construction uses
- 8 at the same or a contiguous site;
- 9 (D) a site at which the materials that are being
- 10 removed or extracted from the earth are used or processed for use in
- 11 the construction, modification, or expansion of a solid waste
- 12 facility at the site or another location; or
- 13 (E) a site at which:
- 14 (i) the materials being removed or
- 15 extracted from the earth are specialty or terrazzo-type
- 16 [terrazo-type] stone removed or extracted exclusively for
- 17 decorative or artistic uses; and
- 18 (ii) the portion of the specialty or
- 19 <u>terrazo-type</u> [terrazo-type] stone horizon that is exposed for
- 20 current production for commercial sale in the site does not exceed
- 21 five acres.
- SECTION 3. The heading to Subchapter B, Chapter 28A, Water
- 23 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- SUBCHAPTER B. REGISTRATION, [AND] INSPECTION, AND OPERATION
- 25 SECTION 4. Subchapter B, Chapter 28A, Water Code, is
- 26 amended by adding Section 28A.055 to read as follows:
- 27 Sec. 28A.055. LOCATION OF AGGREGATE PRODUCTION OPERATIONS

1 IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to: 2 (1) a county with a population of 500,000 or more; or 3 (2) a county that: 4 (A) is adjacent to a county with a population of 5 500,000 or more; and 6 (B) according to the most recent federal 7 decennial census, had population growth of more than 30 percent 8 during the decade preceding the most recent federal decennial census. 9 10 (b) The county commissioners court by order may prohibit the construction or expansion of an aggregate production operation at a 11 12 location less than one mile from a residence, school, place of worship, hospital, or land platted for residential development and 13 14 may establish conditions on the construction or expansion of an 15 aggregate production operation for other locations in the county based on development patterns of the county, distance of an 16 17 operation from a roadway, traffic conditions, emission of dust from an operation, or public safety. 18 19 (c) An order adopted under this section may not result in a prohibition on the construction or expansion of aggregate 20 production operations in the county. 21 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 22 the construction or expansion of an aggregate production operation 23 24 that begins on or after the effective date of this Act.

begins before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law

in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
