11	I solemnly swear (or affirm) that, as an officer:
12	I pledge allegiance to the United States Constitution, and to
13	the republic for which it stands, one nation under God,
14	indivisible, with liberty and justice for all.
15	I will recognize that the authority to perform my duties and
16	powers requires the approval of my actions and behavior by the
17	people.
18	I will recognize that the test of domestic tranquility is the
