2 (3) the <u>fine</u>, fee<u>, or item of cost</u> has been unpaid for 3 at least 15 years; or

4 (4) the fine, fee, or item of cost is otherwise 5 uncollectible.

6 (b) On a finding by a court that any condition described by 7 <u>Subsection (a)</u> [Subsections (a)(1)-(3)] is true, the court may 8 order the officer to designate the <u>fine</u>, fee<u></u>, or item of cost as 9 uncollectible in the fee record. The officer shall attach a copy of 10 the court's order to the fee record.

11 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a 12 fine, fee, or cost imposed before, on, or after the effective date 13 of this Act.

14 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
