Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 7 amended by adding Article 2.33 to read as follows: Art. 2.33. LAW ENFORCEMENT POLICY PROHIBITING MOTOR VEHICLE 8 9 STOP ON SHOULDER OF CERTAIN HIGHWAYS. (a) In this article: (1) "Controlled access highway" has the meaning 10 assigned by Section 203.001, Transportation Code. 11 12 (2) "Law enforcement agency" means an agency of the state or an agency of a political subdivision of the state 13 14 authorized by law to employ peace officers. (3) "Motor vehicle stop" has the meaning assigned by 15 16 Article 2.132. (b) Each law enforcement agency in this state shall adopt a 17 policy prohibiting a peace officer of the agency from making a motor 18 vehicle stop on the shoulder of a controlled access highway. 19 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2022, each 20 law enforcement agency in this state shall adopt the policy required by 21 Article 2.33, Code of Criminal Procedure, as added by this Act. 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 23
